RALEIGH -- Concerned about contamination at Lake Crabtree?

The deadline to send comments to the Environmental Protection Agency about toxic chemicals at the Ward Transformer site near Raleigh-Durham

International Airport is Monday.

The federal agency reported in mid-November that levels of polychlorinated biphenyls, also known as PCBs, were more than 50 times the industry standard at the site. The chemical also showed up in fish at Lake Crabtree and nearby creeks.
